Alternate Delegates may be appointed only at this time in the five-year cycle to ensure representation at the meeting in the event the member cannot attend. The alternate delegate will have the right to vote at the meeting, only if your delegate cannot attend. For this reason, it is critical that the alternate and delegate communicate throughout the months leading up to the stated meeting. If an alternate delegate attends the meeting as your organization's representative, he or she is seated as the delegate for the 2010 meeting only. An alternate delegate is not eligible for elected office.
