Background

During USP's 2005 Convention, several resolutions were adopted directing the organization's activities in the areas of healthcare delivery and patient safety. One resolution, Resolution Nine, resolves that USP will work with appropriate constituencies to develop programs to promote safe medication use and disposal. The background of this resolution discusses the concept of a Compendium of Safe Medication Practices. To that end, the primary focus of the 2006 USP Patient Safety Stakeholder Forum is to explore the concept of such a Compendium.

Goals and Expected Outcomes of Meeting

1. Provide a forum in which key stakeholders can meet and discuss issues related to identifying, collecting, and disseminating interdisciplinary information and guidance on best / preferred / safe practices that span the continuum of the medication use system.
2. Present the USP strategic proposal for the concept of a Compendium of Safe Medication Practices and receive feedback.
3. Discuss the feasibility and utility of creating a Compendium of Safe Medication Practices and address specific questions related to the concept of a Compendium through open forum and panel discussions.
4. Discuss potential content areas that might be considered for inclusion in the concept of a Compendium and discuss potential roles and collaborative opportunities for USP and other organizations related to the proposed initiative.
